Research proposal (1 page) written in consultation with research mentor.

Completion of one year of college level study.

: Preference will be given to students in good academic standing.

Milton L. Fischer Memorial Field Research Fellowship

Requirements:

Student-driven research proposal (2-4 pp).

The proposed work includes an experimental field component.

The proposal articulates how the work “will advance the principle of sustainable relationships between natural resources and society.”

The proposal explains how the research “will support positive change to watershed habitat and populations.”

Valid State hunting and fishing license (must be obtained upon receipt of the award).

Successful completion the Junior Qualifying exam.

Letter of support from faculty mentor.

Dr. Keith Karoly’s signature on cover sheet to certify proposal topic is appropriate for this award.
